Ten "evidence based" classroom techniques for CLIL maths

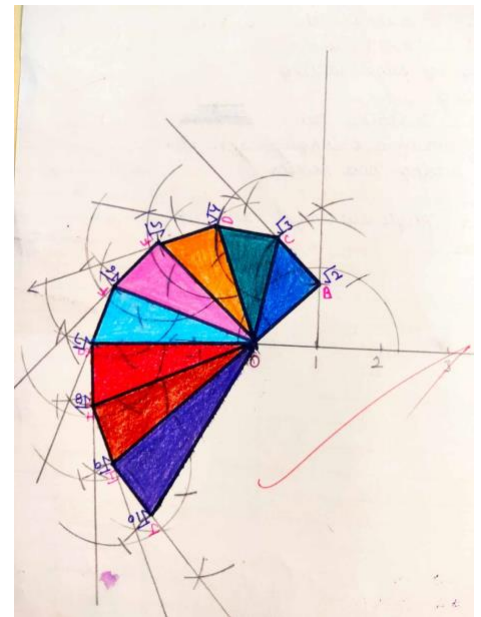
What really works in maths and CLIL classrooms?

Many recent developments in educational research have led to useful new advice on effective classroom practice. However, many good "evidence based" techniques have not been applied to CLIL, so for this **Maths and CLIL 2.0** seminar, we have chosen ten of these techniques which are most relevant to CLIL maths classrooms. These techniques get students thinking, collaborating, remembering and learning in a deeper way. The emphasis in the workshop will be on experiencing and learning practical activities that you can use in your own maths CLIL lessons. You will experience, discuss, evaluate and help design maths activities for CLIL and go home with effective ideas for your CLIL maths lessons.

- ✓ know more about the developments in educational research which feed into maths teaching and CLIL
- ✓ increase your repertoire of effective CLIL maths activities
- ✓ have thought about the best ways to integrate these into your classroom curriculum.
